

Schedule and examination category of the Student Regular Health Checkup in AY 2020

<Health checkup items: **Medical examination** Target : **All students**>

To prevent the spread of the COVID-19, height, weight, and blood pressure will not be measured, but only medical examinations will be conducted.

- It will take place at the Health Care Center for all schedules.
 - If you have fever or cold-like symptoms, please do not come to the venue and call the Health Care Center in advance (096-342-2164).
 - Please refrain from crossing prefectural borders just only for this Health Checkup.
 - Please wear a mask, keep a distance of about 1 meter from the front when lining up at the registration, and refrain from talking or shouting at close range.
 - During the medical examinations, hand sanitization is done and a desk partition is set up for the examinations.
 - If you need a **medical certificate for this year for employment, further education, etc., please come in later to take measurements of your height, weight and blood pressure (student ID card required).**
- Schedule: October 1 - 15 (on weekdays, 9:00 - 11:30 a.m.; 1:00 - 3:30 p.m.)** **Place: Health Care Center**
- In such cases, please note that you still need to have a medical examination on the schedule shown in the table below.
- For those who have completed all health checkup items, including height, weight, blood pressure, and medical checkup, health certificates will be issued through **the certificate issuance system on the Kumadai Portal from Monday, October 19.**
 - If you are in a hurry to obtain the certificate, please contact the Health Care Center for assistance.
 - Chest x-rays for those subject to chest x-rays were ended in April.
 - If you cannot attend the examination on the allotted schedule, you can attend the examination in the same gender schedule, even if you are in a different department, but in order to avoid congestion, please try to attend in the designated schedule.
